In both 2006 and 2009, the University of Lübeck remains No. 1 in medicine among all universities in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. In Computer Science and Molecular Life Science, the University was ranked No. 2 in the 2009 evaluation.

Lübeck is also a growing research university. A prime indicator of the research achievements is the fact that Lübeck has won several times the innovation prize for medical technology funded by the BMBF (German Ministry of Education and Research), with the last one in 2008.
